## EQUIPMENT & TOOLS

- Silhouette Cameo Plus or other die cutting machine
- Silhouette Auto Blade or other appropriate blade for your machine
- Appropriately sized cutting mat for your die cutting machine
- Heavy stock paper of your choice:
  - Yupo 80 synthetic paper
  - 160 gsm cardstock
  - Laminated sheets with or without paper. Laminated sheets work best without paper in Laser Cutters.
  - 80lb Coverstock double sided glossy
  - Reynolds Freezer Paper
- Useful items to have:
  - Knitting colorwork paper and pencils
  - Permanent marker
  - Printer (laser or inkjet depending on the paper you use)
